RELEASE FORM FOR NON-FLIGHT ACTIVITIES
GENERAL RELEASE*

In consideration of the permission granted me by American Airlines, Inc. ("American") to enter upon premises, vehicles, equipment or non-flying aircraft owned or controlled by American or its subsidiaries or affiliates, I agree that such entry is made solely at my own risk, and for myself, my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns hereby (1) release and discharge American, AMR Corporation and AMR directors and employees (hereinafter collectively called AMR) from any and all claims, causes of action, demands, liabilities and actions of whatsoever kind and nature for any injury or damage to myself or my property (including without limitation claims, causes of action, demands, liabilities and actions arising out of my death) which may arise during or out of or in connection with any such entry, including without limitation all claims, causes of action, demands, liabilities and actions attributable to the negligent acts, errors or omissions of AMR, but excluding the gross negligence or intentional misconduct of AMR, and (2) agree to defend, indemnify and hold harmless AMR from and against any and all claims, liabilities, causes of action, judgements, damages, losses or expenses (including without limitation costs of litigation and attorneys' fees) arising wholly or partially from my acts or omissions during or in connection with such entry.
